

WHAT'S NEW?

Construction continues to advance at the high school. Footings and foundations have been poured and the new addition is beginning to take shape. The glass in the front entry windows has been removed to prepare for the new administrative offices located near the cafeteria and kitchen on the ground floor. The exterior wall near the EPAC (Edgerton Performing Arts Center) entrance has been demolished in preparation for the new music collaboration area.

At Community Elementary, walls are continuing to be raised. All exterior walls have their footings and foundations poured, while construction begins on the gym block walls. At the main addition, underground work within the building footprint is scheduled to begin soon, while interior demolition moves forward.

WHAT'S NEXT?

Furniture committees met once again to review and decide on furniture pieces for both the elementary and high school. In December, selected furniture vendors will set up mini showrooms for staff to view and test sample pieces, assisting in the decision-making process. Furniture for classrooms, offices, and common spaces, such as library and resource rooms, will be included in the showrooms.

Construction will continue to progress as the exterior walls begin to form. Inside, demolition will continue at both Community Elementary School and the High School. At Community Elementary School, the interior portions of the 1990s addition have been demolished where necessary. To follow, the electrical, mechanical, and plumbing contractors will remove their components from the building in preparation for the new layouts.
