

When should I get tested?

You should get tested if:

- You have symptoms of COVID-19
- You have been in close contact with someone confirmed to have COVID-19
- You have taken part in activities that put you at a higher risk of COVID-19 infection including:
 - Traveling
 - Attending large social or mass gatherings
 - Being in crowded or poorly ventilated indoor settings

Should I get tested if I am fully vaccinated?

If you are fully vaccinated you should get tested 5-7 days following an exposure even if you do not experience signs or symptoms of COVID-19.

If you have signs or symptoms of COVID-19, you should get tested regardless of vaccination status or prior infection.

What should I do while waiting for my test results?

- Stay home and monitor your health
 - Stay away from others, especially those at higher risk of getting sick
- Trace the spread of infection
 - Gather a list of contacts and approximate times you were in contact with other individuals

- Answer calls from your health department
 - Help public health professionals with contact tracing to slow the spread of infection in your community



What should I do if I test positive?

- Isolate at home for at least 10 days
- If you develop symptoms, continue to isolate for 10 days after symptoms begin
- If you are experiencing life-threatening symptoms, seek emergency care immediately
- For other help managing symptoms, consult your healthcare provider
