On Monday, November 8, teams from each school presented their school level scorecard to the Edgerton School Board. Each team provided an overview of the school's measurable goals, target objectives, strategic actions, and progress monitoring measures. Links to each school's Scorecard can be located on the District website.

The School District of Edgerton scorecards are designed to increase our focus, while also providing improved clarity and transparency for our students, staff, and community. The scorecards are directly related to the District's 2016-2021 Strategic Plan. The scorecards and Strategic Plan are organized into five overarching Pillars of Excellence: Teaching, Learning and Instruction, Students' Social and Emotional Well-Being, Staff Engagement and Effectiveness,

Family and Community Partnerships, and Finance, Facilities, and Operations. Each pillar has specific district level goals that our entire staff work tirelessly to achieve every day.

In August, each school level team conducted a thorough review of various assessments and survey data including local measures and state level assessments. Teams identified areas of strength and opportunities for improvement. The goal of the data deep dive was to understand the story of our student's learning and well-being and then identify goals and objectives for improving performance academically and addressing student's social and emotional health.

Critical to understanding and utilizing our scorecards is recognizing the relationship and connection with each Pillar of Excellence; the measurable goals, objectives, strategic actions, and progress monitoring are all aligned to support the definition of the specific Pillar of Excellence. Furthermore, each school's measurable goals, objectives, strategic actions, and progress monitoring are all aligned to the District level scorecard goals, objectives, strategic actions, and progress monitoring. As a highly effective organization, the progressive alignment of our work is foundational to our continued success.

Updates on the school and district level scorecard progress will be shared with the School Board in February and again in June. Vital to our success is a relentless commitment to providing our students and families the outstanding education our District is known for.
